She earned her bronze medal from the German Riding Federation at 13, and at 16, her silver medal. She has 23 years of experience in classical German dressage, starting young horses and training them through the FEI levels.

Most recently, she spent nine months in 2005 and 2006 training with the Olympic rider, Rudolph Zeilinger at his facility in Emsbueren, Germany. She is also knowledgeable in the science of breeding sport-horses, and has imported a number of German sport-horses for her clients through her company, *Britta Johnston International Sporthorses*. She was a demonstration rider at the 2004 USDF National Dressage Symposium in Lexington, Kentucky, served as a delegate for the American Hanoverian Society to the World Sport Horse Breeding Organization in Guadalajara, Mexico in 2004, was a participant in the Young Horse Trainers symposium at Hilltop Farm, and will be again this year.



Based in Hume, Virginia, she conducts regular clinics as far afield as Long Island, Florida, and Arizona, and taught actively while in Germany. She is now accepting select students in Northern Virginia and near Washington, D.C.
